५. शारिरीक शिक्षण व क्रिडा :- हा ५० मार्कांचा अनिवार्य विषय आहे. या विषयाचे गुणनिहाय विभाजन हे लेखी परीक्षा व प्रात्याक्षिक (खेळाचे) मध्ये करण्यात येतात व वर्ग १२ वीच्या मार्कशीट मध्ये ग्रेड (A/B/C/D) दर्शविल्या जाते.
६. इलेक्ट्रॉनिक्स व कंप्यूटर सायन्स विषय :- हे विज्ञान विभागातील ऐच्छिक विषय असुन सत्र २०१९-२० पासुन वर्ग ११ वी व सत्र २०२०-२१ पासुन वर्ग १२ वी साठी या विषयांच्या अभ्यासक्रमात थोडा बदल झाला आहे. या पैकी कोणताही एक विषय निवडल्यास मराठी व जीवशास्त्र हे विषय राहत नाही. या विषयाची मुल्यमापन योजना ही २०० मार्कांपैकी असते.
७. भौतिकशास्त्र, रसायनशास्त्र, जिवशास्त्र या विषयांसाठी असलेल्या प्रत्येकी १०० गुणांपैकी लेखी परीक्षा ७० गुण व प्रात्याक्षिक परीक्षेसाठी ३० गुण असतील. ७० गुणांच्या लेखी परीक्षेचा कालावधी ३ तास राहिल.
८. गणित आणि संख्याशास्त्र (कला व विज्ञान) या विषयांसाठी १०० गुणांमध्ये ८० गुण लेखी परीक्षा व २० गुण प्रात्याक्षिक परीक्षा.
९. उत्तीर्णतेसाठी आवश्यक असलेल्या ३५ टक्के गुणांमध्ये लेखी परीक्षेत किमात २५ टक्के गुण प्राप्त होणे आवश्यक आहे.

- 13) According to Maharashtra Act. No. XXXIII of 1999 ragging within or outside of any educational institution is prohibited. Who ever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, propagates ragging within or outside college premises on conviction, be punished with in presentment for a term upto two years and a fine up to ten thousand rupees.
- 14) According to adulteration Pretension Rule 51/2000/7(3) of 10/3/2000, a person is strictly prohibited to carry or eat Gutkha, Smoke Segregate or consume alcohol in the college premises. It found responsible directly or indirectly, on conviction, be punished within presentment and fine.
